All Scouts should wear Class "A" uniform and will report to the Check-In table at 7:30 a.m. A wrist band will be issued for the scout to wear, then he will be directed to the assembly area. After a short assembly, the instructors will lead the Scouts in their group to the area/classroom where the merit badge instruction will be held. At a time to be determined by the instructor, the Scouts will, as a group, go to the USA Student Center for lunch.

After lunch Scouts will return to their instruction area. When the instruction time is completed, the Scouts will return as a group to the Check-In table. Wristbands will be removed when the Scout is checked out by his parent.

**Merit Badge Verification:** No Blue Card will be issued. At the conclusion of the event, the instructor will provide the Scout with a document listing the requirements met and those that haven't been completed. ***The Scout is responsible for submitting the document to the Advancement Chair of his Troop.***
