Maubila Scout Reservation April 27-29, 2018

The Family Camping Weekend is simply a two-day Scouting activity designed for a Scout and his parents/family. You come to camp together and do all sorts of fun activities together. You can hike, fish, swim or boat. There will be separate age appropriate activities areas with shooting sports, aquatics, along with some leatherwork in the handicraft area. A camp map and schedule of events and activities will be provided to you at checkin.

WHEN: April 27 - 29, 2018

Check in between 12 noon and 8 p.m. on Friday OR 8 a.m.-11 a.m. on Saturday

Check-out is at 10 a.m. on Sunday

WHERE: Camp Maubila Scout Reservation: Take Hwy 43 North, Watch for the 68 mile marker. About ½ mile

from the 68-mile marker, watch for a sign to Camp Maubila. Take a right and follow the signs to Camp.

WHO: BSA-registered Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Venturers, Scout Leaders, and their parents and family

members

COST: \$19.00 per person. (Children 5 and under camp for free).

What to bring:

<u>each family provides its own tent. You may purchase your meals or provide your own food.</u> You should also bring the following: <u>A TENT</u>, sleeping bags or blankets, cooking equipment (if you are cooking on your own), towels, toiletries, comfortable shoes and socks, weather appropriate clothing, flashlights or approved chemical-fueled lantern, bug spray, rain gear and lots of Scouting Spirit.

The Camp provides:

Accident Insurance for all registered Scouts and Scouters, first aid, shower facilities, planned activities, Camp Staff, Saturday night campfire, Sunday morning Interfaith Service and Lots of fun!!

The Camp has restrooms, showers, drinking water and tables.

Adequate space will be provided to set up your tent.

Camp Safety:

- 1. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED ON CAMP AT ANY TIME. Those found with alcoholic beverages will be asked to leave.
- 2. No vehicles are allowed in campsites.
- 3. Children cannot ride in the back of pickup trucks.
- 4. Shoes and socks must be worn at all times.
- 5. No Flip/flops or open toed shoes.
- 6. No flames in tents at any time. Please use above ground fire pits or specifically designated areas for camp fires.
- 7. No Chainsaws in camp.
- 8. Avoid all snakes and wildlife.
- 9. No firearms, ammunition, or fireworks are allowed.
- 10. Approved chemical fueled lanterns and stoves are allowed for adult use only.
- 11. Youth are not permitted to carry matches.
- 12. Axes and hatchets are for adults only.
- 13. NO PETS or ANIMALS ON PROPERTY.
