



USS ALABAMA BATTLESHIP MEMORIAL PARK CUB SCOUT FAMILY OVERNIGHTER September 28-29, 2018

- WHEN:** September 28-29, 2018 (Check-in between 4-7 p.m. on Friday. Check-out is at 11 a.m. on Saturday.)
- WHERE:** USS ALABAMA Battleship Memorial Park, Battleship Parkway, Mobile, Alabama
- WHO:** All registered Cub Scouts and Families. All Cub Scouts must be accompanied by Adult Partner at least 21 years of age. **This is a parent/child activity.**
- COST:** **EARLY BIRD** Registration fee deadline of \$15.00 per person is 9/14/18 by 5:00 p.m. at the Scout Service Center. After 9/14/18, the registration fee is \$18.00 per person. (Pre-schoolers under 5 attend free.)

The Trading Post (Concession Stand) will be selling pizzas, snacks, and drinks on Friday night only.

Your registration fee pays for and includes a patch for scouts and scout leaders, campfire and a continental breakfast. (Discounted fee for a tour of the Battleship is available from the USS ALABAMA Battleship Memorial Park Ticket Office on Saturday. Children 5 and under are free, children 6-11 are \$5, and children 12-adults are \$13.)

WHAT TO BRING: Tent, flashlight, pillows, money for Trading Post or your own food for Friday, toiletries, insect repellent, sleeping bag or blankets, rain gear, ground cloth.

4. Since this is a family activity, camping is by family members, not by units.
5. A Trading Post will be opened to sell pizza, candy, and soft drinks.
6. Our campfire is to start at 8 p.m.
7. First Aid is available in the Trading Post area.
8. The Trading Post will not be open on Saturday.
9. **NO OPEN FIRES.**
10. Remember a Scout is clean. Please pick up all litter that you bring and take it with you. A bag is provided with your breakfast for your trash.
11. Patches for the Overnighter may be picked up at check-in.
12. Please refrain from smoking while at this Cub Scout event. (If you must smoke, please do so in the parking lot and not near youth.)
13. Please do not leave your Cub Scout unattended or allow them to climb on displays while at the park. **No camping is allowed under the aircraft.**
