CAMP GRACE

October 26-28, 2018 EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION IS BY 10/19 ("Halloween / Fall Festival Theme")

WHERE: Camp Grace: From Mobile Airport, located on Airport Blvd., Mobile, continue west approx.. 3.3 miles to Eliza Jordan Rd.; turn right on Eliza Jordan Rd. and go 1.2 miles; turn left on to Elnina Dr. (Bevis Estates neighborhood); go approx.. 0.2 miles and turn left in the turn of Elnina Dr. into camp property. There is a large overhead sign; Wanda Drive runs between two sets of horses fences. Follow instructions at gate for access to Camp Grace Property

WHEN: Check in Friday between 6-8 pm, Saturday 8-11 am. Check out is at 10 am on Sunday. Do not arrive before 6 p.m.

WHO: All registered Cub Scouts (K – 5th grades), Scouters, and their family members (bring your Halloween costumes!)

What to bring: Each family provides its own tent. You may purchase your meals or provide your own food (no fires or grills or propane stoves permitted. There are three fire pits on camp you may use for cooking; however, they must be shared with a large number of campers.) You should also bring the following: Sleeping bags or blankets, towels, toiletries, comfortable shoes and socks, weather appropriate clothing, flashlights or approved chemical-fueled lantern, bug spray, rain gear and lots of Scouting Spirit.

The Camp provides: Accident Insurance for all registered Scouts and Scouters, first aid, shower facilities, planned activities, Camp Staff, Saturday night campfire, Sunday morning Interfaith Service and **Lots of fun!! The Camp has restrooms, showers, drinking water and tables.** Adequate space will be provided to set up your tent.

Camp Safety: 1. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED ON CAMP AT ANY TIME.**

Those found with alcoholic beverages will be asked to leave.

2. **No Smoking, including all tobacco products, cannabis products and vapor/e-cig products**

3. **No vehicles are allowed in campsites.**

4. **Children cannot ride in the back of pickup trucks.**

5. **Shoes and socks must be worn at all times.**

6. **No Flip/flops or open toed shoes.**

7. **No flames in tents at any time. Please use only designated ground fire pits.**

8. **No Chainsaws in camp.**

9. **Avoid all snakes and wildlife.**

10. **No firearms, ammunition, or fireworks are allowed.**

11. **Approved chemical fueled lanterns and stoves are allowed for adult use only.**

12. **Youth are not permitted to carry matches.**

13. **Axes and hatchets are for adults only.**

14. **NO PETS or ANIMALS ON PROPERTY.**

15. **All adults, youth, scouts, siblings must have a Participant Release form on file with the Fall Fun Rally director (Rick Griffin.) This must be done before arriving at camp or you will need to fill one out in the parking lot before being allowed to enter the camp property.**
